to come home. It’s to reclaim our story.  
God awaits us with open arms, ready to  
embrace and fill us in the ways we need.

Are you ready to “fling open” the doors of  
your heart and let God in? I invite you to  
spend some time in prayer reflecting on  
what that would mean for you:

- *What do you need to be set free from?*
- *Where do you need to come back home  
and truly rest?*
- *How do you need to be renewed in hope?*
